

The Music Centre of the Netherlands Radio and Television, facilitates the ensembles of the Netherlands Public Broadcasting; the Metropole orchestra, the Netherlands Radio Choir, and the two classical orchestras: The Radio Philharmonic Orchestra and The Radio Chamber Philharmonic. Together they form the Classical Unit of the MCO. The two classical orchestras are both artistically and qua personnel closely interwoven. The extensive musical library is also part of the MCO.

The Radio Chamber Philharmonic is a flexible orchestra with a basic capacity of 60 musicians. For modern music and special projects, the orchestra can vary from a small number of players for chamber music up to its full capacity.

From the 2010-2011 season Michael Schøwandt will be the chief conductor. The orchestra plays a prominent part in the concert series of the NPO, such as the "ZaterdagMatinee" and "De Vrijdag van Vredenburg". Principal guest conductors are Philippe Herreweghe and James MacMillan (from the 2010-2011 season). Honorary conductor is Frans Brüggen.
